Here is the bathroom of the Tarzeh coal miners located ۴۵ km northeast of Damghan. Bathroom is the last station at the end of an eight-hour shift. Work is never stopped here. Every day, three teams of miners work hard in three shifts of eight hours, with low wages. Miners take a bath to wash away the blackness of soils and coals from their bodies with the least hygiene commodities, at the end of their shift. Most of the blackness is washed, but with a little care, the blacks that have become old on their lower-arms and fingertips, which have remained for years and will be remained, can be see.

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
